PNH continues to grow and every year there are a record number of videos sent in for coaching, help, Level's assessments and/or resubmits. To aid in the process of video submissions, and to help avoid delays, ensure that you fill out this form completely, and <u>include this form with EVERY video you send in, along with your</u> <u>complete set of Levels task sheets.</u> Please contact Fawn for current assessment rates and a current mailing address to send you video to prior to submitting your video.

As a 3-Star Instructor, Fawn Anderson can officially assess both Level 1 & 2 of the Parelli program. Being officially assessed means that you are registered with Parelli as an official graduate and you are sent a certificate for your level along with a savvy string (red for level 1, blue for level 2) and a levels pin.

1. Fill out your assessment sheets and enter the same information below:

*If you are sending resubmits, be sure to send all of your original assessment sheets!

2. Label the front of your video:

•The sticker should have your full name, the date and what you are submitting. I.e. John Doe, Sept 21, 2007, Level 1 Assessment.

3. Please let us know:

How long is the video? _____minutes •Do the tasks in the same order set out on the task sheet. If not in that order, assessment fee will significantly increase.

4. Keep it all together:

•Fold and attach this letter along with your cheque made payable to Fawn Anderson and all the assessment sheets for your particular level to the video/DVD with a rubber band.

5. Video Returns:

Include a self-addressed envelope with return postage if you would like your video sent back. Otherwise, in most cases, your assessment sheets will only be mailed back to you. It is also a good idea to make a copy of your assessment- do not send the original as videos sometimes are lost in the mail!

Thank you for taking the extra time to do this. It makes a huge difference to the Instructor assessing your video and will speed up the assessment/coaching process.
